UNIFORMS/ATTIRE

ACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Clothing should be clean, unwrinkled and without rips or tears.
- Slacks/khakis/dress pants.
- \checkmark Capris (must be $\frac{3}{4}$ length; calves must be covered).
- Leggings may be worn with long shirt/sweater/blouse.
- ✓ Blazers, collared shirts, dresses, skirts, sweaters, cardigans, blouses, Enchanted Fairies t-shirts may be worn.
- ✓ Shoes should be slip-resistant.
- ✓ Loafers, flats, high heels (under 3" in height), sandals w/closed heel.
- ✓ Jeans w/blazers, collared shirts, or Enchanted Fairies-branded shirts may be worn.

UNACCEPTABLE

- ✓ Sweatpants, sweatshirts, exercise clothing.
- ✓ Pants not properly hemmed, too long or excessively baggy.
- Shorts, miniskirts, skirts more than 1 inch above the knee.
- Bareback dresses.
- ✓ Low-cut, V-necks, halter tops, spaghetti strap shirts, tank tops, t-shirts w/non-company logos, flannel shirts.
- ✓ Tank tops, T-shirts with, flannel shirts.
- ✓ Tight and/or revealing clothing.
- ✓ Beach shoes, flip flops, thongs/between-the-toe shoes.
- ✓ Hats or caps, unless worn for religious or health-related reasons.

HAIR

- Magical colors (i.e. purple, blue, pink, green, bright colors) are ok.
- Mustaches & beards must be clean, well-trimmed, and neat.
- No hats/caps, unless worn for religious or health-related reasons.

FINGERNAILS

Neat and tidy.

 Keep nails clean & short-tomedium length. (This is for the safety of our clients, especially children.)

TATTOOS

Clients & visitors should focus on you, not your body art.

- Excessive and/or offensive tattoos are not allowed to be visible.
- Tattoos must be covered. Small tattoos can be covered with a











band-aid or make-up. Larger tattoos must be covered with clothing.



PIERCINGS

Less is more.

- No excessive facial jewelry, such as eyebrow rings, nose rings, lip rings, or tongue studs.
- No more than 2 earrings per ear.
- Earrings should be moderately sized studs, dangling earrings or hoops.
